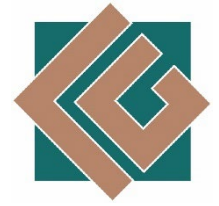
Team Policing – July 2021

This initiative integrates Community Policing into every facet of our department. Beat Teams are comprised of all the Officers who work a particular Beat (District) on different shifts throughout the week. For example, all Officers who work Adam Beat form the Adam Beat Team. These teams meet bi-monthly with community members and each other to identify issues within the beat and devise a solution.

We will utilize internal data at the beat level to identify (5) Hot Spots throughout the City of Casa Grande. Beat Teams then focus on this data within their beats while identifying and addressing other specific problems through community interaction.

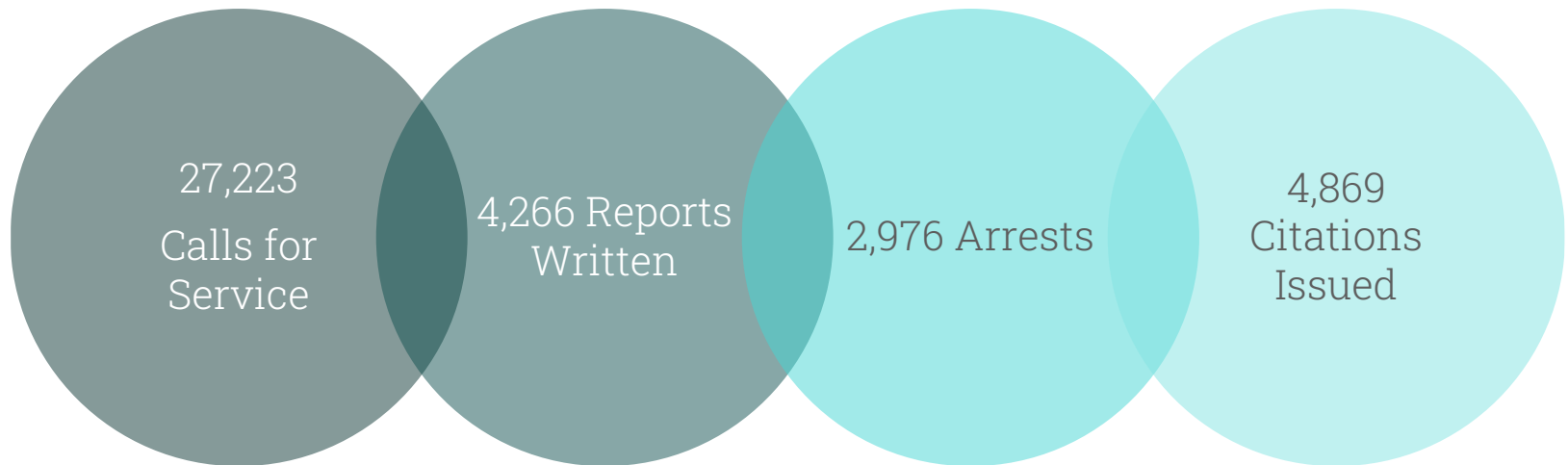


District Map
